Subject: Berkeley Project Day - Saturday, November 6, 2021

Berkeley Project Day is this Saturday. This annual day of service by the University of California students usually happens twice a year in March and November, but because of Covid-19 the event has not happened since November of 2019. The March event is typically attended by over 600 students while the November event is attended by 150-200 students. The students will work in partnership with Parks, Recreation and Waterfront staff at a variety of sites throughout the City. Ohlone Dog Park, Hearst Street at McGee Avenue. 20 Students.
