- Use your phone's tracking and security features.



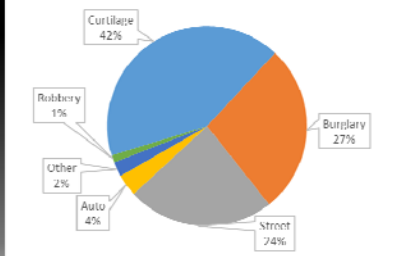

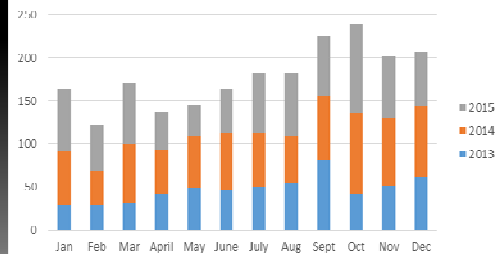
Bike Theft
