75 not limited to: the proposed zoning and General Plan amendments, the City and BART Joint
76 Vision and Priorities for Transit-Oriented Development at the Ashby and North Berkeley BART
77 Station Areas and associated environmental review documents, and/or other documents (e.g.
78 Requests for Qualifications, other agreements negotiated between the City and BART,
79 Objective Design Standards):

- 81 • Establish a commitment by developer to abide to the results of the negotiation
- 82 • As part of request for public subsidy, require disclosure of the amount of public subsidy
83 and the amount and type of affordable units and third-party certification of that request for
84 subsidy
- 85 • Requirement for achievement of adequate sidewalk space for the anticipated users
- 86 • Study strategies for honoring the cultural and historic resources of the Ashby and North
87 Berkeley neighborhoods (e.g. public art, programming of public space, trees and plants)
88 that come from working with the community
- 89 • Drop-off zone for deliveries and separate passenger pick-up and drop-off zone on site
90
