## Parking Occupancy\*\*:

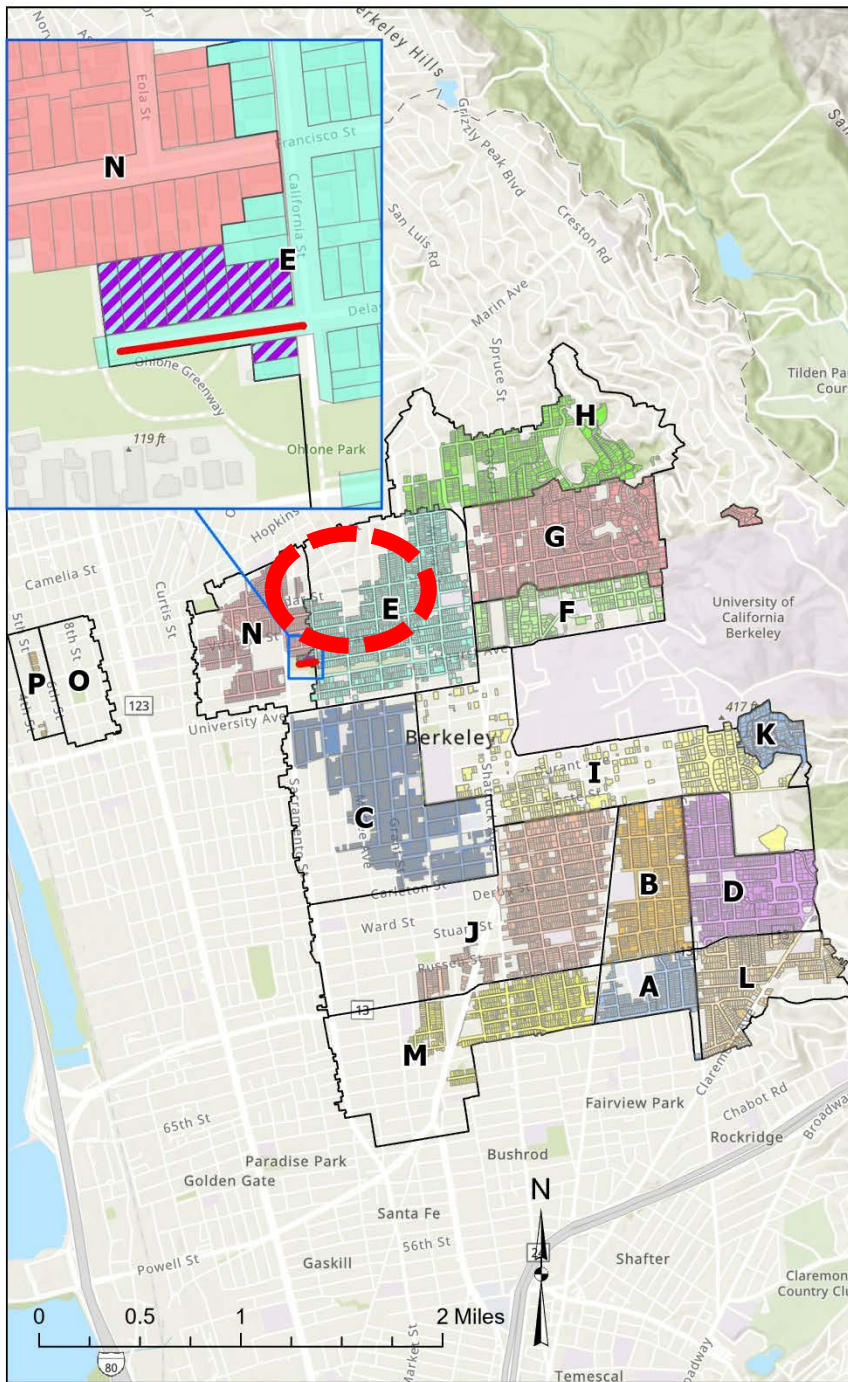
2/4/2026 11:00 am: 10 out of 12 spaces occupied = 83%

\* A minimum of 51% of residents must sign petition to opt-in

\*\* 75% is the minimum parking occupancy percentage to be eligible for RPP

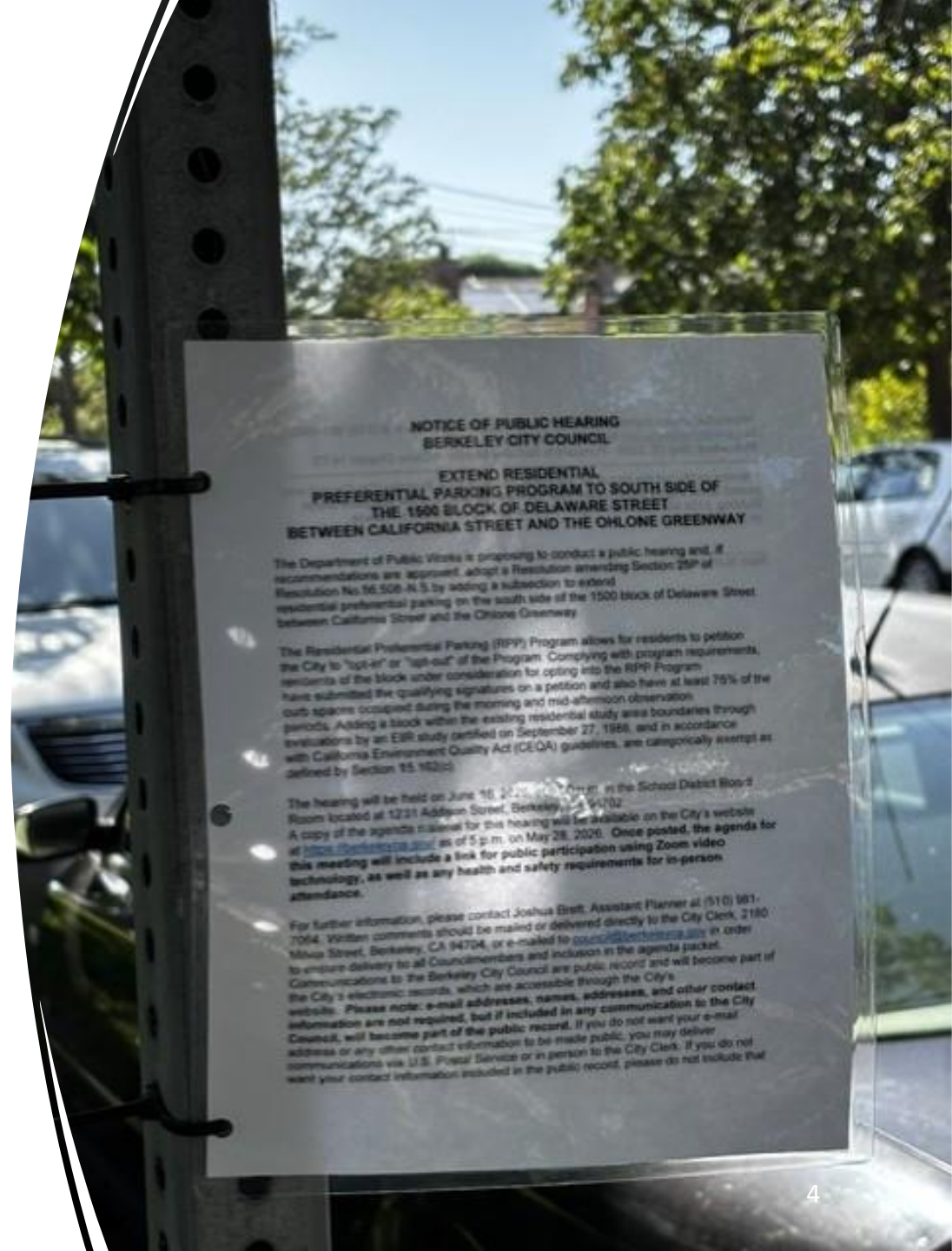

- Parking Permit Enforcement Begins After Signage is Installed
