Phone appointment

Schedule an appointment to talk with a doctor or clinician over the phone – just like an in-person visit.^{1,2} Appointments are often available same day or next day.



Video visit

Meet face-to-face with a doctor or clinician by video for the same high-quality care as an in-person visit.^{1,2} Appointments are often available same day or next day.



Email

Message your doctor's office with nonurgent health questions anytime and get a response usually within 2 business days.²



E-visit

Fill out a short questionnaire about your symptoms online and get personalized self-care advice from a Kaiser Permanente provider.

MinuteClinic and Concentra payment experiences vary by plan. 6. This number can be dialed inside and outside the United States. Before the phone number, dial "001" for landlines and "+1" for mobile lines if you're outside the country. Long-distance charges may apply, and we can't accept collect calls. The phone line is closed on major holidays (New Year's Day, Easter, Memorial Day, July Fourth, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas). It closes early the day before a holiday at 10 p.m. Pacific time (PT), and it reopens the day after a holiday at 4 a.m. PT.
