

# G. Community Education

In the 2024 LHMP Planning Process, the City endeavored to make the Risk Assessment more applicable and accessible to individuals and households. The videos also include a list of Community Actions to reduce risk as well as City Actions in the 2024 LHMP Mitigation Strategy.
