Tenants or others can request a free housing inspection for habitability concerns. Re-inspection fees apply if violations are found during initial inspection and not cleared by the time follow-up inspections are performed. (Annual inspections are conducted by the property owner's designee, and "Schedule A" inspection checklists are self-enforcing.) Give copy to tenant and keep copy for your records. Finance Department Customer Service Center 1947 Center Street, 1st Floor Berkeley, CA 94704	Any housing provider who owns a property with three or more rental units (or provides lodging for 5 or more persons) must register as a Rental Property Business (even if some or all of the units are occupied by the property owner). If business ownership changes, (i.e. rental property is sold) the old owner (the seller) must, within 30 days of selling, file an Amended Business License declaration and pay a business license tax based upon rents collected through the date the rental property was sold. The new property owner (the buyer) must register as a Rental Property Business.
Fire - Prevention	Annual Residential/	Annual Fire Inspections occur approximately every 12 months	The City inspects all properties except single-family residences and duplexes.

Properties must be inspected by full-time Fire Department personnel. Usually billed 30-60 days after inspection; payment due within 60 days of receipt of invoice. Additional fees apply if a re-inspection is required and non-compliance is noted. The re-inspection fee is based on the amount of time it takes to re-inspect the property. A 20% late payment penalty is added if payment is not received within 60 days of the statement date.
