

RECOMMENDATION

The following items were left unranked or recommended for removal because they are already on a Commission workplan or are already being addressed in another committee. In an effort to not reduplicate efforts, we recommended removal or did not rank items that we know are already being addressed.

- Fair Chance Ordinance
 - Already a work priority for the 4x4 Committee
- Improving the City's Elevator Ordinance
 - Already a work priority for the 4x4 Committee
- Auto Sales in Commercial South Area
 - Included in Adeline Corridor Plan
- Junior ADUs
 - Already in Planning Commission workplan

In addition, we request that the following items be considered short term referrals rather than long term referrals:

- Adopt a Resolution in Support of the Good Food Purchasing Program's core values and principles
- Videotaping Planning Commission meetings
- Cigarette Butt Pollution Prevention in South Berkeley
 - Continuation of Downtown pilot program

Finally, we requested that Councilmember Worthington's referral regarding gender identity in City documents be removed because it is a duplicate of Councilmember Robinson's similar referral.
