
**Item Description:** Short term referral to City Manager and budget referral for creation of a “vehicle dweller program” in Berkeley

Removing Councilmember Harrison as a co-sponsor.

At the March 26<sup>th</sup> City Council meeting, the Council approved significant amendments to Ordinance 7,643-N.S. Priority populations for the three-month permit now include families with children in BUSD schools, current students at Berkeley higher education campuses, and people who have had a standard Berkeley address in the past 10 years. In addition, there is now a moratorium on enforcing RV restrictions, except in cases of health and safety violations, until the permit process is in place, which was the primary goal of the supplemental item to Ordinance 7,643-N.S. submitted by Councilmembers Harrison, Davila, and Robinson.

Given the progress and compromise of the March 26<sup>th</sup> meeting, I support waiting until the City Manager’s response to referrals to establish a permitting process, a pump-out station, and other referrals regarding RV parking before moving forward on establishing any vehicle dweller program.
