



STAIR Center Overview



- Opened June 27, 2018
- Three program components:
 - Sustained outreach to City's encampments
 - 24/7, low-barrier and service-rich shelter
 - Large flexible fund to assist clients with access to permanent housing.
- Year 1 Budget = \$2.44M
- Year 2 Budget = \$2.41M

Results-Based Accountability



RBA measures program performance with three key questions:

- How much did we do?
- How well did we do it?
- Is anyone better off?








Gender




How Well Did We Do It?


Occupancy Rate of STAIR Shelter by Month



For all clients enrolled between June 27, 2018 – June 30, 2019:

	<u>STAIR Center</u>	<u>All other Berkeley adult shelters</u>
<i>% exits to permanent housing</i>	64%	9%
<i>Length of time to get housed</i>	~3 months	~9 months
<i>% who return to homelessness</i>	22%	22%
