Make sure to enter your business name and the tax filing period in the payment description field so we can correctly apply the payment to your account. <p>Notes:</p> <p>A. Pursuant to Chapter 7.70.10 of the Berkeley Municipal Code the City of Berkeley imposes a tax on the use of telephone, gas, electric, cable television, and cellular telephone services in the City of Berkeley. This tax is known as the Utility Users Tax and the current tax rate is 7.5%.</p> <p>B. Delinquent date is the last day of the month following the close of the reporting period.</p> <p>C. Penalties: If tax is not remitted by the delinquent date, add a penalty of 10% of the amount of the tax. If tax remains unpaid for a period of more than 30 days following the date upon which the remittance first became delinquent, add a second penalty of 10% of the amount of the tax in addition to the amount of the tax and the ten percent penalty first imposed.</p> <p>D. Interest: In addition to any penalties, add interest at the rate of 0.75% per month on the amount of the tax, from the date on which the tax first became delinquent to the date of payment.</p>
